3. Gliders

- Put together a video to pitch "A Day at Pierson" with the Juniors – possible sponsor opportunity
- Pawnee – at 3D Aviation for maintenance. Maintenance company needs to be chosen according to the job at hand – specialize accordingly.
- Flight Dynamics Pawnee needs to fly for a full month each quarter so that it can be maintained as a safe backup for the ESA Pawnee.
